

- 2 The Company's hutiness activity fulls within a single primary business acquient viz. "Automotive compunents". The operating sugment has been defined based on regular review by the Company's Chief Operating Decision Maker to assess the performance of the Company and to make decision about allocation of resources.
- 3 On account of the spread of COVIU-19, the Government of India had imposed a complete oution-wide lockdown on 25 March 2020 leading to what down of the Company's manufacturing facilities and logistics operations. Since then the government of India has progressively relaxed lockdown conditions and has allowed most of the industries and businesses to resume operations in a phated manufacturing facilities. Management believes that the impact of pandemic seems to be temporary in nature and is not likely to have an impact on the recoverability of the carrying value of in streets at at 31 December 2020. The management is committeed with monthing the developments and possible effects that may result from the current pandemic on its financial condition, liquidity and operations and it actively working to minimize the impact of this improvedented situation. As the situation is still continuously evolving, the eventual impact may be different from the estimates made as of the date of approval of these financial results.
